## Keeping safe and kind in 2020/2021

Due to rise in COVID cases in Omaha we need to adjust our safety policies. Please know that Gingerbread House is not trying to be political. **We are being safe.** We are doing what we can to stay open and provide a fun and safe preschool experience for your children. We realize that some families will feel relief with our safety adjustments and others may not come back to school due to their beliefs. We respect the different decisions during this pandemic. We want you to do what you feel is best for your family as we do what is best for our preschool.

- 1. Starting Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, all students must wear a mask. We have disposable masks in the office if your child doesn't have one.**
- 2. If your child is showing even one symptom, please keep them home. (cough, runny nose, sore throat, diarrhea . . .)**
3. This is the same as before - remember if your child is running a fever (anything over 100) do not send to school.
4. This is the same as before - if anyone in the house has COVID or is being tested for COVID, do not send your child to school.
5. This is the same as before – a temperature check will be done at the door before your child starts class.
6. Call the office if you have any questions about if or when you can send your child to school. We call the County Health Department on a daily basis to check on individual situations and what are the best practices to follow.

We thank you for choosing The Gingerbread House. This has been by far the hardest year for our teachers and office staff. We are trying our hardest to keep open because the joy we see and hear from your children makes us want to continue. Wishing all of you health and happiness.
